My name is Angela Roh and I will be serving as the Under-Secretary General of Outreach for Berkeley Model United Nations' 60th session. I am in charge of our outreach program that works with local schools to establish and develop their Model United Nations programs. Through outreach, we hope to achieve our ultimate goal of guiding today's youth to be globally minded and oriented to become positive forces in improving our world.

It is my honor to formally invite you to the Berkeley Model United Nations Delegate Workshop for the fall of 2011 in mid-October. The Delegate Workshop is an excellent opportunity for delegates to learn the necessary skills to succeed in MUN conferences from our knowledgeable Secretariat. We have two workshops available for students: to teach new students the basics of how to successfully persevere in an MUN conference, and to refine the talents of more experienced students. The Delegate Workshop for 2011 will be held on the UC Berkeley campus, similar to the BMUN conference held in March.

The Delegate workshop is a daylong activity divided into two parts. The morning of the Workshop will allow students to learn MUN skills from our secretariat. After being divided into small classes, new students will learn the basic techniques of giving speeches, writing resolutions and caucusing. Older, more experienced students will have a more in depth session covering international issues and important UN documents. These classroom courses provide delegates with the fundamentals to improve their debating skills. Following a break for lunch, students will be able to put their newly learned skills into action during a mock-conference. During the Workshop, we will also hold an advisors meeting allowing you to discuss MUN issues with other advisors and with the BMUN secretariat.

Keeping with BMUN tradition, we are excited to announce scholarships to the most active and enthused schools at our Workshop. As an incentive for delegates to work hard during the day, BMUN will provide scholarships towards student fees for our conference on March 9-11, 2012. The three schools with the most active delegates will be rewarded for their commitment and interest in Model United Nations.

We are currently in the process of updating our website, so new information is constantly available. Already, you can find this mailing on our website. Continuing on the electronic format of previous years, registration will also be available online (bmun.net). You can find the registration form under the Outreach section of our website.
